In-Person Training

Two-and-a-half-week course

You will learn how to provide basic physical care, understand body systems, age related changes, infection prevention, disease processes, medical terminology and more.

Academic training is presented through lecture, homework and tests. Skills are demonstrated by the instructors. You will practice the skills and be evaluated by the instructors.

The course is completed with three days in a local nursing home where you will provide direct patient care under the supervision of instructors.
